Once a year, the campus is transformed into the finishing line of the biggest relay race in the world, the 'Batavierenrace'. This is a 185km running race, with 8,500 participants, who compete through Germany and finish at UT.

STUDENT LIFE IN ENSCHEDE



Enschede is a city of knowledge and innovation, with a college, a conservatory, an international school and an arts school all next door to UT. This creates a vibrant and diverse student community within the city.

With roughly 31,000 students and a wide range of restaurants, bars, sports facilities and theatres, Enschede has earned the right to call itself a student city. The city has an artistic charm and is home to many museums, galleries and theatres. There are also regular music festivals and events held in the city, often in the central market square.

SHOP

The weekly street market attracts a lot of visitors from the region and from across the German border. The city centre also offers a diverse mix of stores, supermarkets and boutiques.

GO GREEN

There are some great city parks that you can visit in the Enschede area. A favourite amongst students is 'het Volkpark (People's Park)'; only five minutes from the city centre, it's a great place to gather for sports and outdoor games.

SOCIALISE

Right in the middle of the city centre you will find De Oude Markt, a picturesque square with many cafés, restaurants and bars. During hot summer days the terraces fill up quickly with people enjoying the sun, as well as food and drinks – perfect for meeting and connecting with new friends!

EXPLORE

Like most Dutch cities, Enschede is easy to get around by bike or on foot, making commuting both environmentally friendly and cost-effective.



DUTCH STYLE UNIVERSITY

The Netherlands has a population of around 17,000,000 and a student population of around 329,000. Students come from all over the world to take advantage of the country's excellent education system.

AFTER GRADUATION, APPLY FOR A 12-MONTH ORIENTATION YEAR RESIDENCE PERMIT.

All of the Netherlands' research universities are ranked well within the world's top 350 institutions, according to QS. Studying in the Netherlands also tends to be less expensive than other English-speaking countries.

COST-EFFECTIVE EDUCATION

Education in the Netherlands is more cost-effective than English-taught programmes in the UK or US. Additionally, the living costs are lower for non-EU students studying a typical three-year degree.

WELCOMING AND DIVERSE

The Netherlands is a great choice for international students as the country is very diverse. Students can find a wide range of different cuisines and cultural activities to enjoy and it will help them to feel at home.

FUTURE OPPORTUNITIES

The Netherlands has a robust economy with lots of national and international companies looking to take on graduates. International students can apply for a post-study Orientation Year Residence Permit, which allows graduates to live and work without restriction in the Netherlands for a year after graduation. During your studies, you are allowed to work up to 16 hours a week and full-time during your summer holiday.
